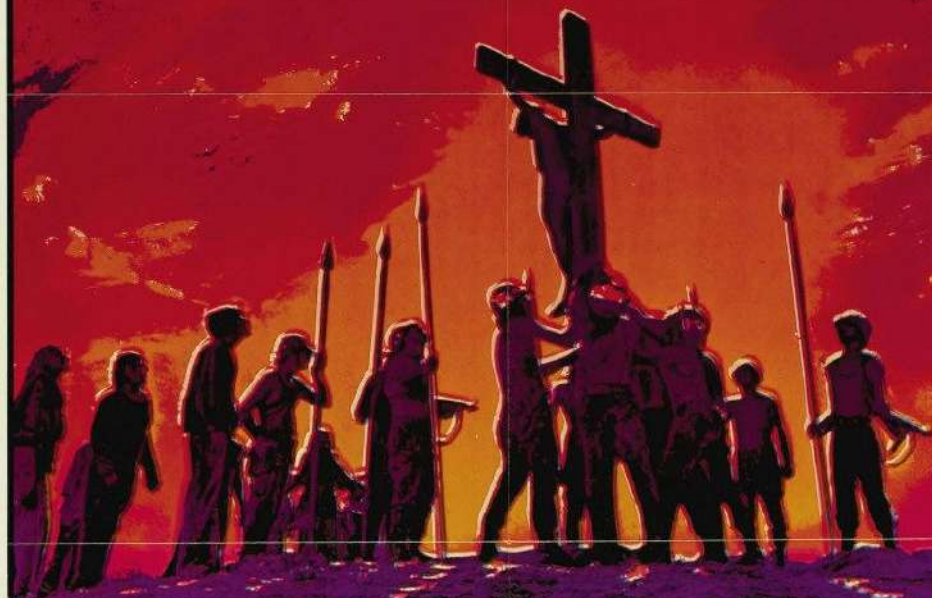

Help Us Share God's Love: What an amazing Sunday! The buckets rang loud as the children walked through the congregation. Last Sunday we collected enough to buy 10 plumps of ducks. This Sunday we will focus on collecting to buy a colony of Bees. Bees are a critical element of agriculture as they pollinate flowers and fields. We can feed children like us!



Fun Bee facts: Lifespan - 4 weeks to 6+ months; Weight - 3,500 bees weigh about 1 pound; the earliest record of honey collecting is an 8,000-year-old drawing in Spain's Arana Caves.

Cost for Each Animal Flock of Ducks-\$20; Flock of Chickens-\$20; Honey Bees-\$30; Garden Seeds-\$60; Pigs, Goats, and Sheep-\$120 each; Water Buffalo-\$250; and Cow-\$500

The Giving Tree is up and going. The Giving Tree corner was overflowing with item collected, 15 large packs of paper goods, 14 Youth blankets, and 7 adult blankets. These were delivered to the Festival of Sharing collection point yesterday, 19 Sep. We are collecting for Maplewood Elementary school next, specific needs will be identified later.



Food Pantry: For September, we are collecting peanut butter and jelly. As of September 13th, we collected 53 jars of peanut butter, 30 jars of jelly, and 27 other items for a total of 110 items. Remember our goal is to send 104 of the monthly items to each food pantry in honor of our 104th Year of McMurry serving in the community. Good start, McMurry.

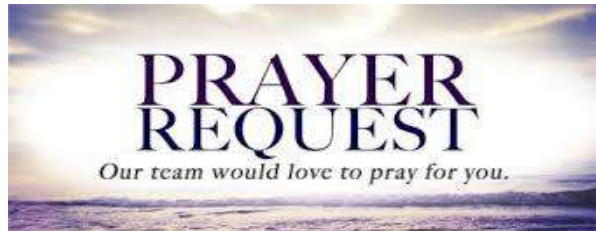
